- BOARD OF DIRECTORS:** The governing body for Clarkston Area Youth Assistance. The Board meets on a monthly basis.
- FAMILY EDUCATION:** This committee plans and organizes workshops on parenting, family concerns, personal development, etc.
- FINANCE:** This committee investigates methods of money management to enhance the value of fundraising efforts. They also aid in budget preparations, presentations and audits.
- FUNDRAISING:** This committee plans and implements fundraising events as well as assists in grant identification and identifying donation sources.
- MENTORS PLUS:** This committee works locally to identify, recruit, and support potential mentors.
- PUBLIC RELATIONS:** This committee works on promoting Clarkston Area Youth Assistance within the community.
- RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT:** This committee analyzes youth and family trends and researches programming ideas to address these needs.
- CAMP:** This committee is responsible for distributing and screening camp applications, evaluating camps, dispensing camp scholarship funds, and assisting with the camp registration process
- YOUTH RECOGNITION:** This committee plans and organizes the annual Youth Recognition event. The committee also distributes and screens nominations as well as presents formal awards to deserving youth in the community at the event.
- HOMEWORK CLUB:** This committee works with homework assistance or specific needs for K-12th grade students primarily living in Bridgewater Park Apartments.
- PINWHEELS FOR PREVENTION:** This committee organizes and implements the planting of pinwheel gardens throughout the community in April for Child Abuse Awareness and Prevention Month.
- MEMBERSHIP:** This committee actively recruits volunteers for CAYA.
- YOUTH INVOLVEMENT:** This committee is made up of youth who identify issues among peers and create programs to address those concerns.
- RECREATION:** This committee plans and coordinates recreational activities for families and youth.
